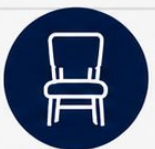

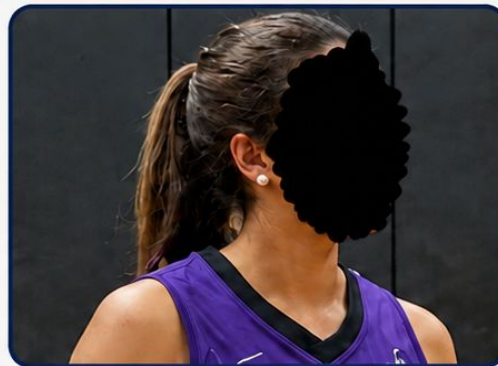

NFHS PRE-MATCH COIN TOSS

A smooth start leads to a great match.



BOTH OFFICIALS SHOULD BE ON THE SAME SIDE TOGETHER WITH BACKS TO THE SCORE TABLE.



COACHES SHOULD PRESENT THE R2 WITH THE ROSTER AT THIS TIME—**EVEN AT TOURNAMENTS.**



BE QUICK WITH INFO (LESS THAN 2 MINUTES IS ABOUT ALL THEY HEAR).



CONDUCT COIN TOSS (VISITOR CALLS TOSS) — WINNER GETS CHOICE OF **SERVE OR RECEIVE**— SIDES SHOULD HAVE ALREADY BEEN DETERMINED BY HOME TEAM.



NOTIFY TABLE OF OUTCOME.



CHECK ROSTERS—YOU ARE ONLY COUNTING BODIES, **NOT CHECKING #'S**—R1 & R2 CAN WORK TOGETHER.



WARM-UP SHIRTS ARE LEGAL IN WARM-UPS!

THEY DON'T HAVE TO REMOVE THEM
**OFFICIALS ARE COUNTING BODIES, NOT
CHECKING #'S.**



UNSPORTSMANLIKE CHANTING ON SERVE

FROM GLORIA COX...

UNLESS A TEAM DOES SOMETHING THAT IS BLATANTLY UNSPORTSMANLIKE (LIKE BE SILENT, THEN AS SERVER IS ABOUT TO CONTACT THE BALL, THEY MAKE A BIG BOOM), WE DO NOT EXPECT THEM TO BE QUIET.

IT SHOULD BE EXPECTED THAT THERE WILL LOTS OF NOISE IN THE GYM, SO PLAYERS LEARN TO IGNORE IT.

IF SOMETHING RACIAL OR PROFANE IS YELLED, THAT SHOULD BE ADDRESSED.



OUT-OF-BOUNDS CALL

The NFHS ruling

The NFHS Officials Manual's **Out-of-Bounds/Antenna Violation Signal (Signal 14)** includes this situation:

"The ball goes into the net and lands out of bounds on the attacker's side."

In that situation, the official should **signal out of bounds**, not a touch/block. This is specifically identified as an NFHS officiating situation. docsity Docsity

There is also an NFHS officials discussion that identifies the source as the **NFHS Casebook and Officials Manual, page 87**, stating:

"The ball goes into the net and lands out of bounds on the attackers side."

OFFICIALS' ETIQUETTE

1. BE EARLY-ARRIVE AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE GAME TIME!



2. ADHERE TO THE UNIFORM POLICY-EVEN AT TOURNAMENTS-BLACK SOCKS, BLACK WHISTLE, BLACK LANYARD (PINK ONLY IN OCTOBER)



3. IF COACHES ASK YOU TO MOVE GAMES TO OR FROM YOUR COURT, DO IT. COACHES ARE IN CHARGE. IT IS THEIR HOUSE. THEY CAN DO WHAT THEY WANT TO DO ABOUT WHERE/WHEN THE GAMES PLAY.



4. ABSOLUTELY NO SELF-ASSIGNING-ASSIGNMENTS ARE MADE BY THE ASSIGNORS ONLY!



5. IF YOU CANNOT MAKE IT TO AN ASSIGNMENT, CALL & TEXT THE ASSIGNOR/S AND LEAVE A MESSAGE.

NFHS Volleyball Weekly Rule Interpretations

Two Liberos – FAQs

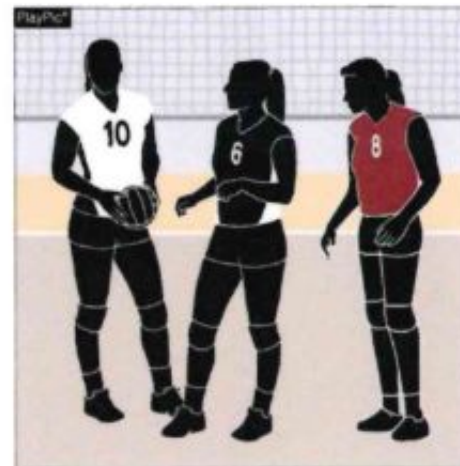
NEW RULE: A team may designate zero, one or two liberos, but only one libero can be in the game at a time.

UNIFORMS

Q. Can the liberos wear two different uniform colors?

A. Yes – Each libero may wear a different color uniform, if both libero uniforms clearly contrast with non-libero teammates.

SITUATION 1: The team is wearing white uniforms, the L1 is wearing black, and the L2 is wearing red. **RULING:** Legal. (4-2-2a)



LIBERO INFO CONT'D

SERVING

Q. Can both liberos serve?

A. Yes, but they are tied to the same serving position.

SITUATION 2: L1 serves in position IV on the lineup. After L1 scores three points, the L2 exchanges for the L1 and serves two more points. **RULING:** Legal. (10-4-1a, 10-4-5a)

SITUATION 3: L1 replaces No. 21 and serves in position IV. Two rotations later, L2 replaces No. 6 and prepares to serve in the sixth position. **RULING:** Illegal. **COMMENT:** L2 completes an illegal libero replacement by replacing someone other than No. 21 in the serving position. The L1, L2 and No. 21 are tied to that serving position and it is an illegal replacement if the L1 or L2 attempt to enter the set for another player in position to serve. An unnecessary delay (administrative yellow card for the first offense or administrative red card for a subsequent offense in that set) is charged to Team S if identified before contact for serve. If identified after contact for serve, an illegal alignment (loss of rally/point) results. (10-4-1a, 10-4-5a, 10-4 PENALTIES 1)

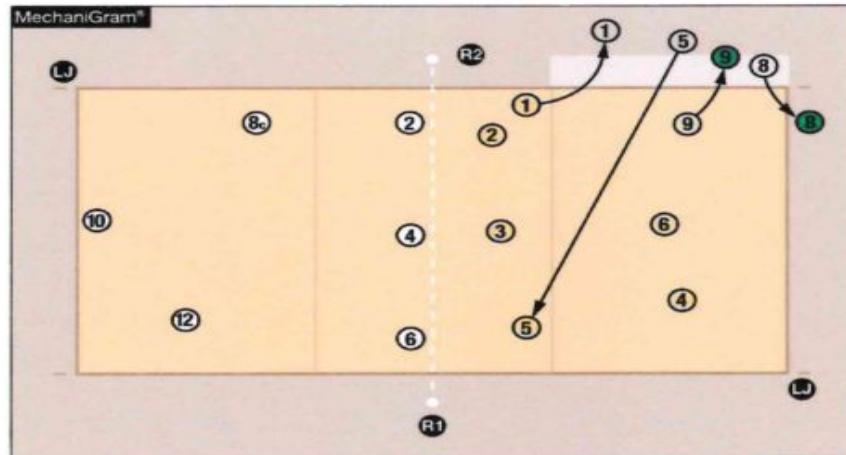
LIBERO INFO CONT'D

REPLACEMENTS/EXCHANGES

Q. Can a libero replacement and exchange occur during the same dead ball?

A. Only when the L1 is moving directly to the serving position and the L2 will serve.

SITUATION 7: Team R wins the rally and the L1 (No. 9) completes a libero exchange with L2 (No. 8) who assumes the serving position. The entering position player (No. 5) completes a replacement with the exiting position player (No. 1). **RULING:** Legal. **COMMENT:** A replacement and an exchange can occur on the same dead ball when a libero is replacing the player serving in the right back position without leaving the court. (10-4-1d)
